

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY& DISCRIMINATION



It is against the law for a sponsor of an apprenticeship program to discriminate against an apprenticeship applicant or apprentice based on:

- Race
- Color
- Religion
- National origin
- Sex (including pregnancy)
- Sexual orientation
- Age (40 years or older)
- Genetic information
- Disability

NEED HELP?

If you think that you have been subjected to discrimination, you may file a complaint within 300 days.

Each complaint filed must be made in writing and include the following information:

- 1. Your name, address and telephone number.
- 2. The identity of the entity responsible for the discrimination.
- 3. A short description of the events that you believe were discriminatory.
- 4. Your signature or the signature of the complainant's authorized representative.
