✓ **Know Your Agreement**

Make every effort to understand your registered apprenticeship program by following the terms of your agreement.

✓ **Attend Related Instruction**

Instruction is required as part of your training program. Attend instruction regularly.

✓ **Follow Safety Rules**

Learn and follow safe working procedures. Your safety and the safety of your fellow workers is crucial.

✓ **Track your hours**

Maintain records of work experience and related instruction. Your employer should also keep track of your progress.

✓ **Know your timeline**

Know how long your apprenticeship should take to complete and know the next steps.
