- ✓ Attend Related Instruction Instruction is required as part of your training program. Attend instruction regularly.
- ✓ Follow Safety Rules
 Learn and follow safe working procedures. Your

safety and the safety of your fellow workers is crucial.

✓ Track your hours

Maintain records of work experience and related instruction. Your employer should also keep track of your progress.

√ Know your timeline

Know how long your apprenticeship should take to complete and know the next steps.
