How it Works

- 120 instruction hours, delivered in a student's junior or senior year
- Topics include industry awareness, health and safety, math, labor history, diversity, blueprint reading, green construction, financial literacy
- Technical assistance and administration through Building Futures

Registered Apprenticeship The Other 4 Year Degree

Registered Apprenticeship is:

- Employment & post-secondary education combined
- Structured on-the-job learning supplemented by classroom instruction
- Driven and designed by employers to provide the most relevant technical skills

Registered Apprenticeships take between 6,000 and 10,000 hours on-the-job (generally 3-5 years) to complete. The length depends on the trade.

As skills and time on-the-job increase, so do apprentice wages and responsibility.
