How to Recognize an Overdose

Know the Signs

Breathing slowly

A person may move slowly, have shallow breath, make gurgling noises, or stop breathing



<u>Can't be woken up</u>

They may be awake but unable to talk or may not respond when you try to wake them

<u>Turning blue</u>

They could look very pale or have blue fingernails and lips



<u>What to do next</u>

Call 911, give naloxone, and begin rescue breathing if the person doesn't respond
