## Rhode Island Celebrates National Apprenticeship Week, November 15-19, 2021

Rhode Island will celebrate National Apprenticeship week with a series of events that highlight the transformations and expansions in the Registered Apprenticeship system to date and outline the road ahead. DLT was recently awarded \$4M federal State Apprenticeship Expansion Equity and Innovation (SAEEI) Grant for its Apprenticeship FORWARD project that will modernize and expand Registered Apprenticeship Programs and increase the diversity of programs and participants. The SAEEI funds will continue the highly successful Apprenticeship Rhode Island partnership between DLT and Building Futures.

Registered Apprenticeship has a unique role to play in economic recovery, providing an earn while you learn opportunity for Rhode Islanders and a proven talent development and retention strategy for employers. In 2017, Building Futures launched Apprenticeship Rhode Island, in partnership with DLT, to expand the use of Registered Apprenticeship in high-growth industries across the state with the following results:

- 38 new (non-construction) occupations now have Registered Apprenticeships
- 42 Registered Apprenticeship programs have launched with 100+ employers
- 1571 new apprentices are earning while learning in private industry statewide
- 45% of apprentices across all industries are from underrepresented populations
