Apprentice Card

You must carry a valid apprentice card at all times while on the job. If you leave your employer/sponsor to work for another employer, you must re-register.

Licensed Trades

For the licensed mechanical trades, apprenticeship is the path to licensure. It is illegal to be on the job unless you are licensed or a registered apprentice. If not, the employee and the employer can be fined.
